Contra Dance Weekend- Feb. 13 - 14

Atlantic Crossing will be the featured band at this weekend dance, along with the calling of The Good Luck Gals. Atlantic Crossing uses over a dozen different instruments to create the music of Ireland, Scotland, England, Eastern Europe, and the U.S.

The Good Luck Gals are the well known callers Deb Comly and Peg Hesley. With a combined 25 years of experience, they are sure to keep us dancing throughout the weekend.

The weekend starts and ends with a regular contra dance. The Friday and Saturday evening dances have a lesson at 7 PM, with dancing from 7:30 to 10:30 PM.

Saturday afternoon will feature a zesty contra dance from 2:30 to 5 PM. Zesty contras are designed for more experienced dancers. These dances have unusual features such as no walk through before the dance starts that might be frustrating for many new dancers, but are enjoyed by more experienced contra dancers.

All 3 dances are at Kenilworth School, 1210 N. 5th Ave., Phoenix, 85003. The Friday dance is \$12 / \$10 for members. The Saturday dances are \$10/\$7 for each dance.
