Spring Frolic Dance - April 23

Nationally renowned contra dance caller Kathy Anderson returns to Arizona to call the dances for the Phoenix Spring Frolic Contra Dance, sharing the stage with Tucson's The Privy Tipplers. Kathy has been calling and writing dances since 1982, from Alaska to Florida and in the Bahamas and Europe. She is known for her energetic, smooth flowing contras, exciting squares, quick clear teaching and a great sense of humor.
